Ticket to Ride is open to community members 60 years of age or older and people with ADA recognized disabilities.

Rides are available for:

- Medical Appointments
- **♦** Shopping
- **♦** Work or Volunteering
- Social Events

In the case of limited availability, TVT dispatchers will prioritize medical trips first, followed by food access then social trips.

To enroll in the program, call the TVT Orange / Northern Windsor office at (802) 728-3773. A dispatcher will ask you a few questions to confirm your eligibility for the service.

Rides Provided

Effective April 1, 2021 Ticket to Ride participants are offered the following rides:

- ♦ 100% of rides for Critical Care appointments will be provided to include: kidney dialysis, cancer treatment, or cardiac rehab – these rides are in addition to the six allowed trips per month.
- ♦ Six (6) Round Trip Rides per month within the TVT Orange/N. Windsor Regional Service Area. Rides for medical specialist appointments out of the service area are allowed, but additional documentation may be requested.
- ♦ Four (4) personal (non-medical) trips per year are allowed out of the TVT-Orange/N. Windsor service area up to 40 miles each way. Longer trips may be scheduled if the rider will pay for additional mileage expenses. These trips <u>will</u> count towards the six rides allowed per month.
- TVT may schedule rides with volunteer drivers in their personal vehicles, on TVT accessible vehicles, on TVT fixed route bus service, or a combination of these. TVT Dispatchers will schedule the most cost effective and efficient mode of transportation to meet your needs.


