

TITLE VI OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT

VERMONT STATE PUBLIC ACCOMMODATION LAW

9V.S.A.4502 (a) Public accommodations states an owner or operator of a place of public accommodation or an agent or employee of such owner or operator shall not, because of the race, creed, color, national origin, marital status, sex, sexual orientation, or gender identity of any person, refuse, withhold from, or deny to that person any of the accommodations, advantages, facilities, and privileges of the place of public accommodation. If you feel you have been discriminated against, you may file a complaint with Vermont Human Rights Commission by calling (800)416-2010 or email human.rights@vermont.gov.

ADA REASONABLE MODIFICATION POLICY

In accordance with FTA 49 CFR, Parts 27 and 37, Tri-Valley Transit is committed to ensuring a reliable, accessible experience for all customers. All requests for reasonable modifications to TVT programs and services will be considered on an individual basis. Please note that TVT may be unable to accommodate requests for reasonable modifications which would result in a fundamental alteration to the nature of TVT programs and services, or which would directly interfere with the health and safety of others. If a barrier to access exists, but the requested modification cannot be granted, TVT will, to the maximum extent possible, assist in determining an alternate reasonable modification to provide equivalent access to its programs and services.

For more information on TVT's reasonable modification and the procedures to file a request or complaint, you may contact TVT's ADA coordinator. You will receive a written confirmation of your complaint from TVT within three (3) business days. Copies of ADA Complaints will be retained for one (1) year and a summary will be retained for five (5) years. ANIMALS - PETS AND SERVICE ANIMALS

Service animals are allowed on TVT buses. Pets are also allowed if in a carrier or wearing a muzzle and leash. All animals must be under control at all times to ride. Other bus systems may not allow non-service animals on board. If you are planning to continue your trip with another transit provider you should call ahead to verify their animal policy.

BIKES

All TVT buses are equipped with bike racks. Each rack can accommodate two bicycles. Bicycles may also be brought in the bus if necessary and space is available. At this time electric bikes are not allowed on the bike racks or inside the buses. Riders are responsible for loading and unloading their own bicycles, and they must be strapped down for safety. Motorized stand-up scooters are not allowed unless needed for an ADA disability.

CHILD SEATS

All TVT buses (excluding micro-vans) have built-in child seats in the first row.

DEVIATIONS & REQUEST ONLY BUS STOPS (R)

Addison Region buses deviate up to 1/2 mile (1/4 mile for Rutland Connector and Saturday LINK to Burlington) from the published routes to pick up or drop off passengers. There are no deviations on the 116 Commuter or Monday-Friday LINK to Burlington buses.

Some TVT bus stops are listed as "R" or Request Only – either all of the time or during some parts of the day. Request Only stops follow the drop-off and pick-up procedures below, stopping at the nearest safe location.

To request a DROP-OFF

Upon boarding, please let your driver know you would like a Deviation or a Request Only drop off. The driver will let you know if this can be accommodated right away or on the next loop. All attempts to accommodate requests will be made.

To request a PICK-UP

We ask that all pick ups – whether a Deviation or Request Only Bus Stop – be requested by calling your local office one business day (24 hours) in advance, or on Fridays for a Monday pick up. However, we will always attempt to fill requests that are made with less notice.

Dispatch staff will take the information, review the bus schedule and determine a Pick Up time. Per federal law, the ride will be accommodated either up to one hour before or one hour after the requested time. **TVT dispatch staff is available by phone Monday – Friday between the hours of 7am-6pm, 802-388-2287.**

LARGE ITEMS

Skateboards, skis and snowboards are welcome on the bus provided they are kept out of the aisles. Motorized stand-up scooters are not allowed.

LOST AND FOUND

TVT is not responsible for items left on the bus. Perishable and soiled items will be disposed of for safety reasons. All other items found on the bus will be brought to the office and kept in our lost and found for 30 days. Call 802-388-2287 for lost and found information.

TRANSFERS

Please confirm with driver when boarding if you need to transfer to another bus or route. Connecting buses can wait up to 5 minutes beyond scheduled departure times for transfers. **Exceptions: Weather** – all buses may be delayed due to severe weather; TVT will make every effort to make connections. **Time of Day** – at the end of the day, when there is no other way for a rider to reach a destination, TVT will make every effort to make connections.

WHEELCHAIR LIFTS AND SPECIAL ASSISTANCE

Wheelchair lifts are on every bus and drivers are trained to assist rider who need them in getting on and off the bus. To ensure the best possible service, riders needing special assistance are encouraged to call 802-388-2287 ahead of time. Please note, the step height to board our buses is between 10" and 12".

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. No arguing, violence, threats, bullying or harassment.
2. No swearing or mean words about race, gender, age or sexual orientation.
3. No weapons.
4. No items that could cause a fire.
5. No smoking, vaping, illegal drugs or open alcoholic drinks.
6. No soliciting any product or service.
7. No open food or drinks. (Lidded drinks are okay.)
8. No excessive noise or speakers. Use headphones or turn off sound.
9. No littering or sticking anything out the windows.
10. No taking more than one seat or putting your feet up.
11. No exposed body fluids.
12. Sit behind the line while the bus is moving and keep the aisle clear.
13. First row seats are for riders who are older, have a disability, or need child seat belts.
14. Wheelchair tie down areas are reserved for wheelchairs, walkers and mobility scooters.
15. Riders must be fully clothed and limit odors that disturb others.
16. Stay in control of your service animal.
17. Ask driver for help securing large items.
18. Leave the bus after one loop (unless another partial loop is needed to get where you are going.)



HOW TO RIDE

1) Register.

Contact us by website, mobile app or phone to provide your contact info and any ADA needs.

2) Reserve rides.

There are three way to reserve your EZ Trip rides:

Need repeat reservations?

Recurring ride requests can be made up to 21 days in advance of your first requested trip.

3) Be ready.

EZ Trip van will pick you up and drop you off as close as possible to your locations. Please wait outside before the assigned time so our driver can see you.

EZ Trip will pick you up within 5 to 30 minutes from the time you contact us. During booking you will receive estimated pick-up and drop-off times.



Rides are provided on wheelchair lift-equipped vans.

NOTE: The EZ Trip van does NOT serve traditional bus stops at regular intervals or stop for riders who try to flag it down.




